

SEA ANGLING TRIPS



Do I need to have fished before?

No. The trips are designed as relaxed sea angling trip, enjoyment being the main priority. The fishing is mixed. Mackerel with other species such as coalfish, pollock, dogfish, ling and even skate putting in an appearance.

What about tackle and bait?

All tackle and bait is provided. However, you are welcome to use your own.

Will we catch something?

It is almost unheard of for a trip to come back empty-handed, but even if you do, the scenery is stunning.

Can we keep what we catch?

You may keep as much of the catch as you wish.

Where do we go?

This very much depends on the weather and where the fish are. The decision is made on the day by your skipper.

Who is the skipper and what boat is it?

The skipper is Geoffrey (Gallagher). The boats are a white 8.3 metre catamaran called Gemini or Tiger Lily III, an Interceptor 38. There are toilet facilities and there is a cabin. However, it is best to take some warm clothes as it will be cooler at sea than on land.

Where do I book a trip?

Here at Tackle and Books. Geoffrey can take no more than 12 (it does not matter whether you are fishing or not). It is uneconomical to sail with less than 5 adults or 6 persons including children.

There are three lengths of trip 2, 3 and 4 hours

Trips are by demand. Children are under 14

The shorter trips are best for children and families

Trips leave from the Pontoons (beside the Harbour Visitor Centre)

Meet at the boat on the pontoon 10 minutes before sailing

What does it cost?

3 hour trip (10am til 1pm) £32 adults, £22 children

4 hour trip (1.30pm til 5.30pm) £42 adults, £32 children (no small children)

2 hour trip (6pm til 8pm) £22 adults, £15 children

You pay in advance at Tackle and Books. This books your place.

If for any reason Geoffrey does not sail, your money is refunded in full.

Does the skipper cater for parties?

Yes. To charter the boat we can contact Geoffrey and organise a time.
